OUR MEETING ROOM HAS CHANGED

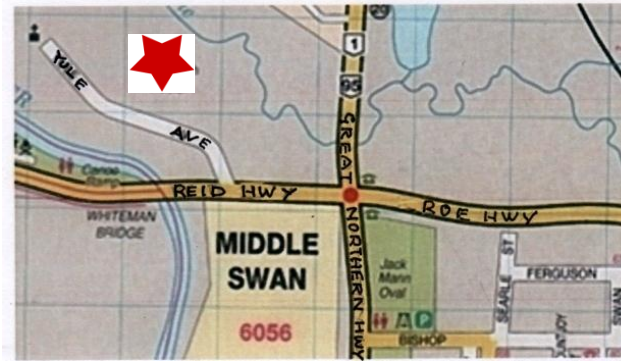
