Nominations for Assembly

We are also receiving nominations for WA members of the 15th Assembly to be held in Melbourne in July 2018.

According to the Regulations the WA Synod may appoint 7 ordained persons and 9 lay persons. The Moderator and General Secretary are ex officio members.

Presbytery may nominate one ordained person and one lay person and will do so at the meeting in November.

We do already have a number of nominations – these are available for view in the foyer.

Assembly Nomination forms are also available for further nominations.

If required, a ballot will be held at 5pm.

Nominations for President-elect

Nomination forms for the President-elect of the Uniting Church in Australia are also available from the Nominating Committee. Official nominations close on 9 April 2018.

The Synod may make a nomination at this meeting, otherwise nominations may only be made by two members appointed to be members of Assembly.

Presbytery and the regional committee of the Uniting Church Aboriginal and Islander Christian Congress may also make a nomination.

If required, a ballot will be held at 5pm.

A final report of the Nominations Committee together with a hardcopy of Commission memberships will be made at 2.15pm on Sunday afternoon.
