

You are invited to attend a special series of studies, ***Commending the faith in Australia today***. These studies will be led by Rev Dr Chris Walker, who has recently completed serving the National Assembly as National Consultant on Ecumenical Relations, Doctrine and Worship.

Chris has recently undertaken a special study of “Apologetics”, which is the art and craft of explaining the Christian faith, defending the faith against challenges and criticisms, and commending the life of faith in Jesus as an exciting and viable way of living.

He will be offering these four evenings to members and ministers of the Uniting Church Western Australia. This is a good Continuing Education opportunity for ministers. Lay people are especially encouraged to attend. Please consider inviting others from your congregation to attend. There will be ample opportunity for discussion, responding to the input that Chris will provide each week,

and considering the implications for the way in which you live as a faithful disciple in the society of 21st century Australia.

The sessions will be held at the Willetton Uniting Church, 16 Herald Ave, Willetton. Tea and coffee will be available each evening, with a \$5 donation accepted on the night to cover this cost.
