
Our deepest sympathy goes to Rex's family, Sally and Mike, Jenny, and Lindy and Robert, and to his many friends.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM CHURCH COUNCIL

Having remained virtually Covid-free for so long, it was inevitable that the Omicron variant would eventually arrive in West Australia, but it is disconcerting that the virus is establishing a strong foothold here, even before our border has fully opened to the rest of Australia and the world.

Last week the South Perth Uniting church temporarily closed after a member of that congregation tested positive to Omicron. This event, combined with the prospect of 60 or so people from different Uniting Churches descending on All Saints on Friday for Summer Spirit, has galvanised your Church Council into decisive action in order to protect the All Saints community.

For the time being, effective immediately, in addition to registering with the QR Code, all persons entering All Saints will be required to produce, as a minimum, proof of double vaccination. I say for the time being, as double vaccination is the Health Department's current requirement. However, that is expected to change in the near future, at which point anyone who has not received a third dose within six months of becoming double-vaccinated will no longer be considered "adequately protected".

I would point out that Council is not requiring any more from you than is now expected for you to gain entry to restaurants, cafes, gyms, hotels and other indoor venues where public gather.

Importantly, you will not be required to produce proof of your vaccination status every time you attend worship. A register will be kept and once you have provided proof there will be nothing further required of you. Proof may be either in the form of the certificate on the Service WA App on your phone or a hard copy of the same certificate downloadable from your Medicare account in the MyGov website.

Please, do not feel daunted by this. If you have not yet acquired proof of your vaccination status and are unsure of how to obtain the necessary certificate, a friend or family member will more than likely be able to help you. However, remember that the All Saints community is your extended family and, if all else fails, I or one of my colleagues on Council will do our best to resolve your concerns.

This step that Council has taken was motivated by two considerations only, firstly to keep you all safe and secondly to ensure, within our power, that All Saints can remain open for worship during these difficult and challenging times. In this endeavour we pray for God's guiding hand and the blessing of his infinite Grace, Amen
