Faith Leaders speak out against the North West Shelf

Summary:

Faith leaders are deeply troubled by the decision from the Federal Government to approve the extension of the North West Shelf gas processing facility out to 2070. Concern is particularly focused on climate impacts of the decision and the threat to the Murujuga cultural heritage.
